Students completing grades 3 – 7 will enjoy age-appropriate educational and recreational activities. Historical interpretation, hands-on demonstrations and skills, crafts and games, all based on the 1840s time period, and using the tools and techniques of that time. Each camp will have a maximum of 20 students to ensure individualized attention and learning opportunities.

## Camp Sessions:

Four day camp sessions are held Wednesday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Beginner I and II are for kids who have never attended Pioneer Camp before. Advanced is for kids who have attended the camps before. The fee is \$50 per child per session, which includes appropriate clothing and noon vittles (lunch) each day, and all supplies.

Session II: July 15-18 Grades 5-7  
Advanced: July 29-Aug 1 Grades 5-7
